This list comprises all of the 479 bird species that have been recorded in the Province of Ontario, on the basis of specimens, photographs, recordings and documented sight records accepted by the Ontario Bird Records Committee (OBRC) to March, 2006. A total of 289 species is known to have bred in the province. Classification and nomenclature follow the American Ornithologists' Union Check-list of North American Birds, 7th Edition, 1998, and its 42nd - 47th supplements. The most recent additions are: **Neotropic Cormorant** (2006), **McCown's Longspur** (2006), **Cackling Goose** (split from Canada Goose, July, 2004), **Brewer's Sparrow** (2004), **White-collared Swift** (2002), **Manx Shearwater** (2002) and **Heermann's Gull** (2000). The common name Mongolian Plover is now **Lesser Sand-Plover** (2004) to agree with modern Old World literature. The common name Rock Dove changed to **Rock Pigeon** (2003). The name Three-toed Woodpecker changed to **American Three-toed Woodpecker** (2003) as a result of a split from the Eurasian species. The name Common Snipe has been changed to **Wilson's Snipe** because of a split from the European species (2002). In 2005 and 2006, the order has been changed in the following list to reflect the AOU order.
